Describe it in the Study:



redefined tenon is formed.


Describe it in the Study:

Describe it as a Person:


According to the study, harmonious students are those who are balanced with their academics, relationships, and social life. These students are usually amicable and congenial, with little to no unnecessary disagreement with others.





Living Study A. North Elevation



Bronze.









Texture of Blossoming.

General Info:

Bronze can be found in some of the architecture within the surrounding Chinatown. The material is known for its hardness and brittleness, but less brittle than cast iron. It also has a high resistance to corrosion from saltwater, which is why bronze is often used for ships and marine instruments.

Tectonics:

The material is primarily used as a "connector" between the wooden moving parts of the reading room.

- 1. As an enclosure, the material is reflective of who and what is being enclosed, giving light to the details of objects.
- 2. At a corner, bronze is malleable, making it fit into the shape of wooden corners smoothly.
- 3. At a seam, the material demonstrates a more modern and industrial visual in contrast to the traditional wooden visual. The bronze columns also come together to form a rotating tectonic by using a long cylinder and corresponding hole.

Distinct Features:

The finish is overall shiny when new, yet can be dull when weathered down. When it is weathered down, it produces a green-blue color due to the oxidization of the copper component. The material turns this color to prevent further corrosion. Similar to the blossoming hidden behavior, bronze blossoms into a new color as it "grows" with age.

Opacity:

Bronze is overall opaque with its metallic aspect, however, when it ages, the material finish can become cloudy and dull.

Textural Relief:

The overall appearance of bronze is polished, shiny, and hard. However, when aged, the material becomes matte and slightly coarse in areas of weather.

Finish Location:

Bronze is primarily placed at the pivot and hinge columns of the reading room. In contrast to the traditional wooden members that represent nature, bronze represents an age of modern industrialism by humans. As parts of the room are rotated, visitors can glance at their reflection within the new bronze and be reminded of age within the dull, weathered bronze.

Wood.









Texture of Harmonious.

General Info:

Wood is generally found within the Los Angeles State Historic Park through its bridges and welcome center buildings. The material is known for its sustainable nature, tensile strength, electrical and heat resistance, as well as its sound absorption. Visually, wood can be most known for its grainy and natural crevices.

Tectonics:

The wooden parts of the room are either connected to the same material, or to a pivoting or hinged bronze material. However, all the wood members are the same nominal size.

- 1. As an enclosure, the wood incorporates small overhanging pieces that act as places for shade for the visitors.
- 2. At a corner, the single size of wood comes together into double the scale by connecting four of the same nominal lumber pieces.
- 3. At a seam, some lumber pieces can be held together by nails or plates.

Distinct Features:

The overall appearance of the wood is grey, similar to the ones used in the park's lower bridges. The wood grain is also subtle and light, making the planks seem more in contrast with one another. The material is overall harmonious because of its connection with nature and the ability for it to be reused and recycled again.

Opacity


The material is opaque, expressing the wood's honesty and bluntness.

Textural Relief:


The overall appearance of the material is rough, bumpy, stiff, and slightly coarse due to the wood's natural sawn texture.

Finish Location:

The wood is used within all of the non-pivoting points of the reading room. It is meant to act as the traditional and static features of the room in comparison to the dynamic and modern bronze members. The wood calls back to the importance of nature and how nature is being used and appreciated through today's architecture, especially in a park with green emphasis.




Reading Room. Axonometric scale: 1/4"=1'=0"




Reading Room. Top View




Reading Room. Cut Plan A scale: 1/4"=1'=0"










Reading Room East Elevation



Room. Cut-away Axonometric




